



Job Site Safety Rules

Arrive On Time – 7:45 a.m.

Volunteers arriving after the Safety Training will not be allowed to work on site.

Wear Safe Clothing

- Sleeved shirts
- Closed toe shoes with gripping soles
- No baggy pants or short shorts

Work Smarter, Not Harder

- Use goggles, hard hats, earplugs, gloves
- Follow instructions
- Stay with Habitat team leader
- Stay in your comfort zone
- Take breaks
- Stay hydrated
- Use sunscreen

Be Aware Of Your Surroundings

- Watch out for other workers
- Keep site clean
- Stay alert
- NO cell phone use on construction site – please leave the site if you must use your phone

In recognition of the federal labor laws regarding children and the potential risk to children's safety of a construction site, no one under the age of 16 will be allowed on the construction site while construction is occurring. Further, no one under the age of 18 should be allowed to do any of the ultra hazardous activities. These activities include the use of power tools, motor vehicles, demolition, roofing, working from a height of six feet or more and excavation operations.
